SUBJECT:	Art

	includes the class work and homework tasks you have been working on to meet the Assessment Objectives.
What resources should I use?	You must ensure your sketchbook is in school and you bring any loose work you wish to submit in support of your
	coursework. You are allowed and encouraged to look at your sketchbook work to support you with drawing and
	decision making in the exam.
	Any art materials you wish to use will be provided but you are welcome to bring own paints/brushes/pens if you wish.

What the exam will be like	You will have a 5 hour exam which will be sat over the course of 1 day (with usual break/lunch).
